

ISANS COPYRIGHT GUIDELINES

Introduction

ISANS produces a variety of published materials for instruction (e.g. English as a Second Language course books) and information (e.g. Profiles of Immigrant Entrepreneurs).

All ISANS materials are covered by the terms of the [Copyright Act](#), by Canadian laws, policies, regulations, and international agreements. Such provisions serve to identify the information source and, in specific instances, to prohibit reproduction of materials without written permission.

Reproduction of free information

Non-commercial reproduction

Free information may be reproduced, in whole or in part and by any means, without further permission from ISANS, under the following conditions:

- The reproduction is done only for the purposes of private study, research, criticism, review, newspaper summary, and/or for non-commercial purposes.
- Users are careful to maintain the accuracy of the information reproduced.
- ISANS is acknowledged as the source of the information

The following notice should appear, in an appropriate area, in any document or Internet site that includes selections of the content of ISANS materials:

ISANS information is used with the permission of ISANS. Users are forbidden to copy the information and disseminate it, in an original or modified form, for commercial purposes, without permission from ISANS. Information on the materials produced by ISANS can be obtained from www.isans.ca.
